All-day or not - How can I decide?

How should I imagine everyday life in an all-day class?

In the all-day class, there are the same subjects as in a regular class and just as many lessons. However, the lessons are spread out over the whole day. Phases of lessons alternate with other, additional offers in a sensible rhythmic way. For example, a creative activity can also take place in the morning, but mathematics can also take place in the afternoon. In all-day classes, there is usually a tandem teacher. This teacher does not contribute as many hours as the class teacher, but is also a reference person for the children. In addition to the two teachers, a larger number of external partners enrich the high quality of the programmes. Through more supervised time and work in multi-professional teams, all-day classes have the opportunity to support pupils individually and to focus on their needs for healthy and holistic development.

But it is also true that in order for children to get as much as possible for themselves from our additional services, they need to be able to

- adapt quickly to changing reference persons,
- reliably sticking to rules even in the afternoon when strength is a little weak,
- to work increasingly independently on the tasks in the learning time (comparable to "homework time"),

- to follow the offers with interest and openness until 3.30 p.m., although we encourage "free play" at the same time, especially in the first grade,

- to read with the parents after 3.30 p.m. or to learn a poem by heart and to do a little homework.
- to do homework also on Fridays or weekends.

What offers are there in the all-day programme at the Mönauschule from external partners?

Our all-day programme includes: social training, creative activities, music, KISS (= Children in School and Sport), yoga, school garden, cooking, theatre, chess, cultural foxes, The older the children get, the more the proportion of compulsory lessons increases.

How much will it cost me with a child in all-day care?

The all-day school is basically free of charge. However, you have to pay for lunch: 10 times a year 75,50 \in . The Erlangen Music School charges an administration fee of 20 \in for its offer (once at the beginning of the year).

All families are asked to buy their own consumables such as notebooks and pencils. We will lend your child school books free of charge. You will receive a list of materials for the 1st grade at school enrolment.

How does my child get into an all-day class?

Please indicate your interest in a full-day class at the latest during school enrolment. Fill out the registration form for an all-day class and send it to us as soon as possible. It does not matter whether you live in the primary school's area or not. You can obtain the registration form from the secretary's office or by e-mail. Children who live in the district do not automatically receive a place in the all-day class.

Children are admitted to the all-day class upon application by their parents or guardians. If more applications are received than there are places available, the school management reserves the right to make a selection according to social criteria or to fill the places by drawing lots.
